

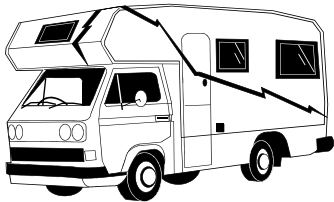
We need you! Volunteer today
